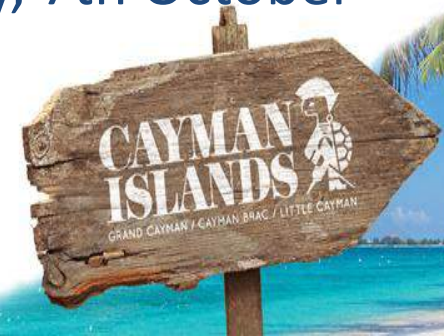

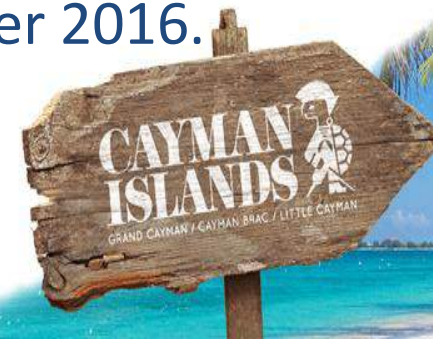

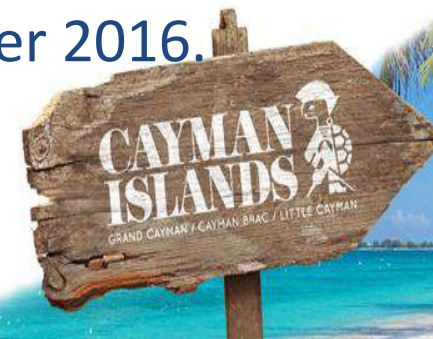

BERTHING FACILITY UPDATE

- The International engineering firm Royal Harkening DHV, have been appointed by the Central Tenders Committee to provide Civil Engineering Consultancy Services for the proposed George Town cruise berthing facility.
- The firm is charged with designing the pier which will assist with determining the cost of the piers to achieve the least possible environmental impact.
- The Government and Ministry of Tourism has concluded that repositioning and constructing the piers in deeper water would require less dredging and lessen the impact on the environment.
- The next step is to determine the standards and specifications of construction. The redesign will inform the by early in the fourth quarter of the year.

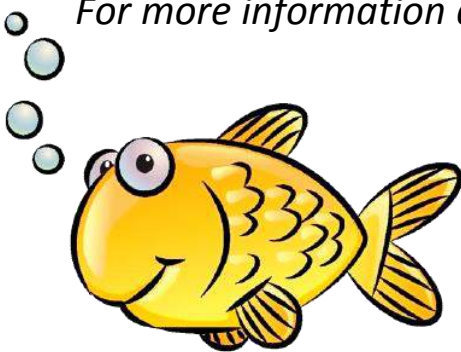


INTERNATIONAL SCUBA DIVING HALL OF FAME (ISDHF)

DEVELOPMENT SUMMARY

- Kimpton Seafire Resort + Spa scheduled to open in November 2016.
- The “Residences” segment of hotel developments are treated as long term rentals unless individual residence/condominium owners become licensed in the short term accommodations rental pool.
- Project development delivery timelines are updated quarterly
- 3 year outlook anticipates an additional 961 short-term rental tourism accommodation rooms
 - Approximately 20% increase to Destination room stock.
