- Cayman Enterprise City is a Special Economic Zone in the Cayman Islands. The project will be showcasing “green” buildings and will be a sustainable and environmentally friendly campus. Buildings will be set around a 10-acre lake, which will be the epicentre of a dynamic sustainable urban park.

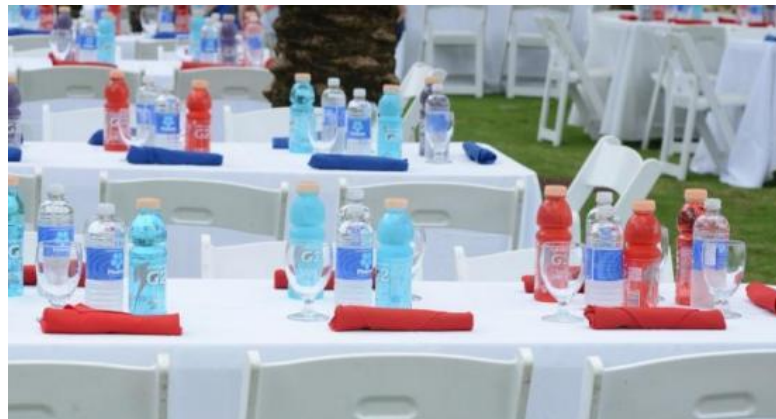

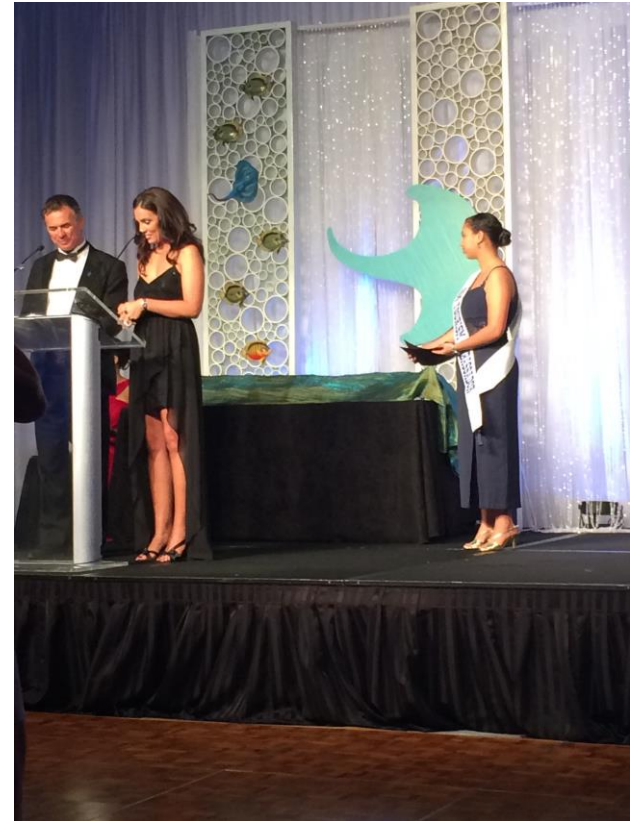
